Where are we Going?

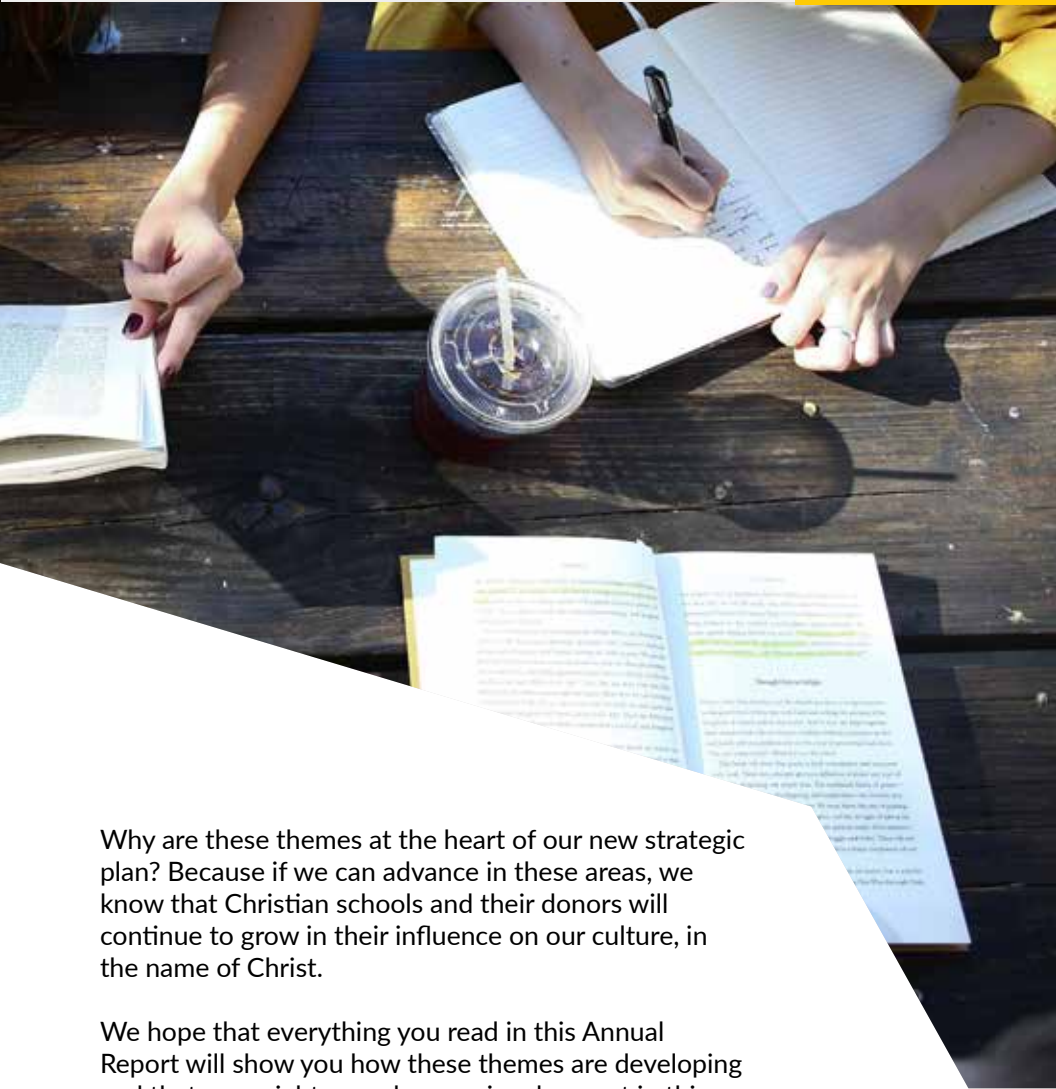
The Christian School Foundation Board and Staff recently engaged in a series of strategic planning activities. The many activities we have envisioned for the next few years coalesced around these four themes.

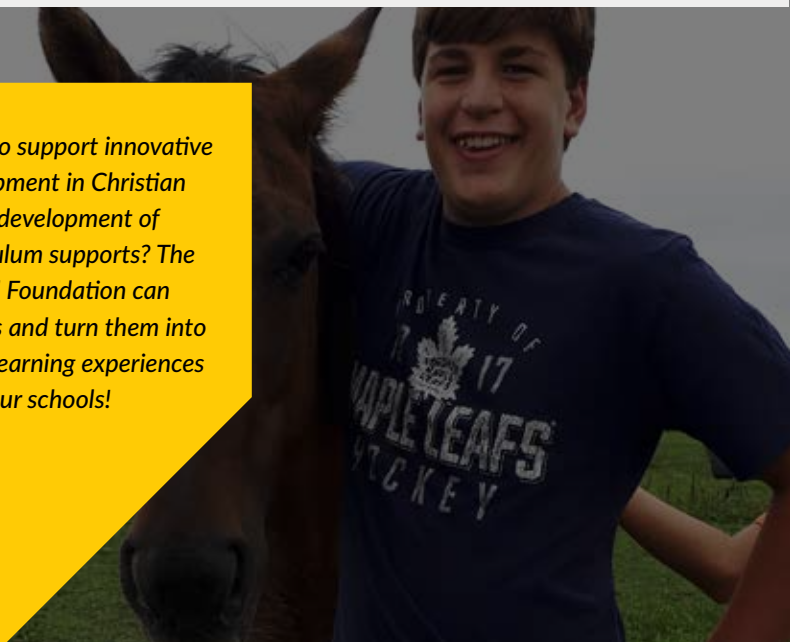
Would you like to support innovative program development in Christian schools? Or the development of Christian curriculum supports? The Christian School Foundation can accept your gifts and turn them into transformative learning experiences for students in our schools!



What happens if students don't like school? We often work on their attitude, try enhanced strategies to make things less frustrating, and generally work on making them a better "fit" for our system. While these skills are important, perhaps we could look a little more into adapting our learning experiences to "fit" the students, rather than assuming traditional schooling is the only way!

At Chatham Christian School seven of our students from intermediate grades spend some of their week at "The Farm". These students were struggling at school and we were concerned they would start

to believe they were not smart and had less value than others. Yet we knew these students loved to do tangible work they felt mattered, had a desire to please their teachers or leaders, and had an untapped work ethic that wasn't shining through as they sat at their desks. At The Farm these students care for horses, mend fences, tend to gardens, and assist the lead farmer in other projects. We have plans to add other animals and projects to the farm experience in the future. We are seeing them learn about science, math, and nature in a way that fits their learning style.

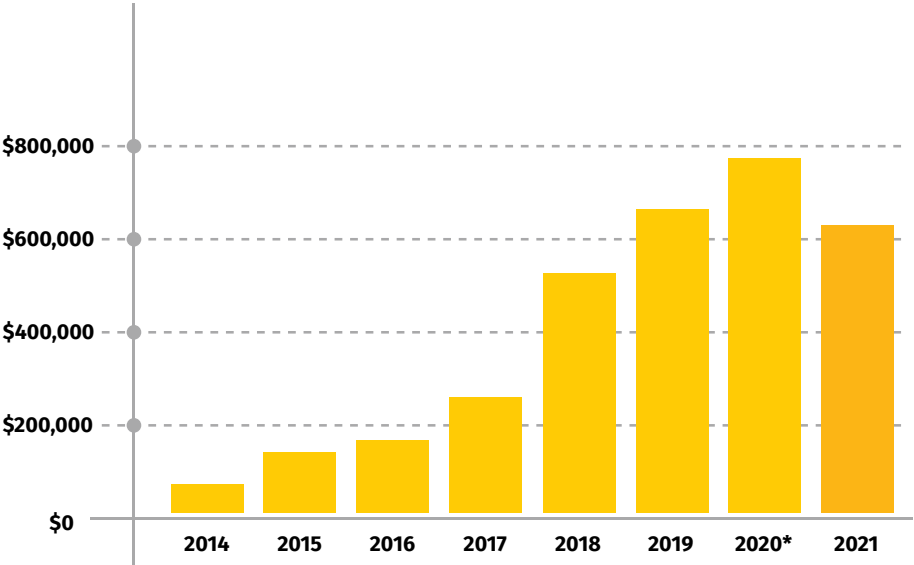

COMMUNAL INVESTING

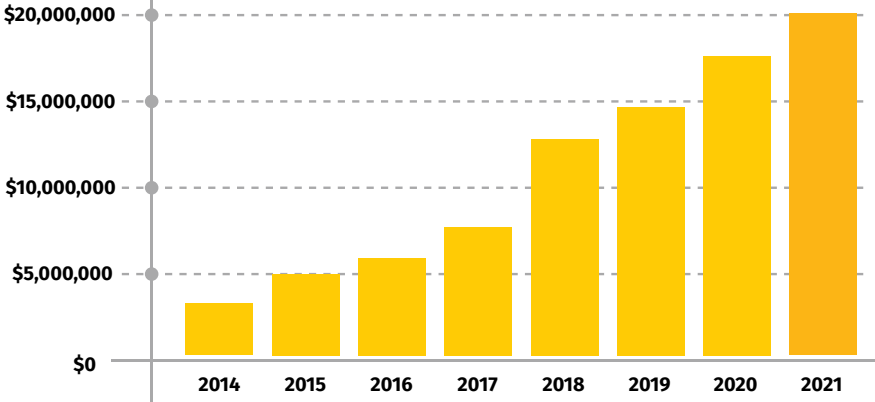
Many Christian schools have been blessed with medium and long-term gifts. Our hope is that eventually all are.

Being a good steward of these gifts can be a challenge for an individual school, but together we can strategically pool and invest our communal long term assets and gain access to better investment options and lower fees. At the same time, monies given for your school are held as externally restricted assets and can only ever be used for your school, yet your school reaps the benefits of a professionally managed and diverse portfolio.

We are humbled by the outcome of the Foundation's portfolio for the fiscal year that ended on June 30, 2021. God blessed our efforts with a blended pool net return of **9.51%** (after all fees), the best historical outcome realized since many of our predecessor foundations were established in the 90's. Of course we can't offer any assurances that this outcome can be met again or exceeded going forward, but at the same time we know that ultimately He is in charge.

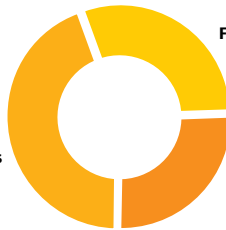
